The Prizes

And here's how it works.

Archers who choose to join, become “**WA 300 Club**” members and donate to Wymondham Archers £5 per month, per ticket, for 1 year.

The Rules...

- Each WA 300 Club member contributes £5.00 monthly per ticket from the first week of May each year.
- Each WA 300 Club Member must be a current Wymondham Archers club member throughout the period of the 300 Club ‘year’
- The WA 300 Club ‘year’ begins in May each year and prizes are awarded after the final payment in April the following year.
- Payment must be received by **BACS** only, within the first week of each month.
- Payments must be made to: **Wymondham Archers 2, Sort 20-45-45 Account: 40391328** Annotated with “**300 space [Name]**”.
- No reimbursement can be made if WA 300 Club members leave or default on their payments within the current year.
- If a WA 300 Club member ceases paying into the scheme, prior to the full year of donations, their name will be withdrawn from the final draw entries, no refunds are given
- If a WA 300 Club member dies, Wymondham Archers will offer to refund (to their family) their subscriptions for the current year in full, or if fully paid up and a prize has been won; the Prize money
- New members to Wymondham Archers and to the WA 300 Club can join throughout the year; with adjusted payments, to ‘catch-up’. A single initial payment equalling the sum paid by other members of the WA 300 Club year to date, and further £5 monthly fees until the end of the WA 300 Club year and equal the final draw-date sum, as accrued by all other members of the WA 300 Club.

- Adults may contribute for junior members of their family, but all prizes will be awarded to the responsible adult for passing on to their junior; should the juniors name be drawn for a prize.
- Members may donate additional funds to the club by paying for more per tickets purchased as additional voluntary contributions. The extra funds can not be used later to obtain additional tickets
- All other issues will be acted upon by the Executive Committee of Wymondham Archers.
- These rules will be under constant review and may change or be amended at any time. Any significant change will be agreed upon by the Committee and minuted prior to being applied.
