Saffron Housing Trust has made a donation of £1500 for the initial equipment, a reply from Sports England is expected in June.

Neil announced that plans for beginner's courses are being made to enable us to increase our membership above the present 20 members. We have sufficient members to make the club viable. We were visited by Radio Norfolk to interview Kenny and some of the other members.
